

Hear the Gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ, according to Mark.


Glory to you, Lord Jes-us Christ.

The Fourth Robin Sharwood Lecture in Church Law

Will the Ties that Bind Break Under the Strain? – The Future for the Constitution of the Anglican Church of Australia

This topic is relevant in light of the current issues facing the Anglican Church after the Commonwealth legislative reforms permitting same sex marriage and the recent Appellate Tribunal decisions in regard to the blessing of marriages, including same sex marriages, and clergy discipline.

Since 2014 she has been the Chancellor of the Diocese of Brisbane, having previously served as Deputy Chancellor since 2004.
